C. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

1. Bill of Sale
2. Builders Certificate (if a new vessel)
3. Certificate of Survey (including tonnage certificate and calculation) to be prepared by a recognized classification society
4. Certificate of Incorporation (if current owner is a company incorporated in a British jurisdiction)
5. Copy of passport and driver's license of the owner(s) (and in the case of a company being the owner, provide copy of passports and driver's licenses of all shareholders, directors and officers)
6. Letter of reference from bank, trust company or other financial institution with whom you have done business for two (2) or more years
7. Letter of reference from a lawyer or accountant who has known you for at least two (2) years and is not related to you.
